2 Role of the Judge


- Works with leaders of partner agencies and other stakeholders to establish clear roles and a shared mission and vision; and engages them in the development, implementation, and ongoing operations of the FTC
- Convenes team meetings to identify shared values, voice concerns, and find common ground.
- Develops rapport with participant (*among the most important components of the FTC)
