


MEDICATIONS FOR OPIOID USE DISORDER (MOUD)

Child Dependency Courts

Medications for Opioid Use Disorder (MOUD) is an evidence-based treatment that **supports recovery** and **reduces both relapse and overdose risk** for parents involved in child welfare cases who are struggling with opioid misuse.

How it Works

Relieves physiological symptoms and withdrawal

Normalizes

Blocks euphoric effects of opioids

brain chemistry

MOUD Facts

MOUD is an evidence-based treatment, **NOT a** substitution of one addiction with another.

MOUD is not a short-term fix; effective treatment can be long-term or even lifelong.

MOUD **does not impair parenting** capacity when taken as prescribed.

Court-ordered discontinuation of MOUD can be **dangerous**, unless supported by the treating provider, and violates state and federal laws.
